SOCIETY OF ACTUARIES PRESENTS LIVING TO 100 AND BEYOND ONLINE MONOGRAPH

The number of people living to advanced ages is certain to increase dramatically over the next 25 years, significantly impacting individuals, business and governments worldwide.

To address these issues, the Society of Actuaries, in conjunction with more than 30 international participating organizations, held the second Living to 100 and Beyond: Survival at Advanced Ages Symposium. The monograph features the groundbreaking papers from the symposium contributed by authors from around the world, representing countries such as Canada, China, Germany, India, Japan, Mexico, Philippines, Taiwan, the United Kingdom and the United States. In addition to the papers, there are lively transcribed question-and-answer sessions and interesting contributions from discussants.
